1. Online Access: I acknowledge that copies of daily and monthly statements (activity generated) will be available online when I access “My Futures Account” on Global’s website (www.globalsec.com). Daily statements will appear in your online account early in the trading day immediately after the day on which a trade is made. Monthly statements will appear in the same way shortly after each month-end. In order to access statements delivered in this manner, I will have to use my Global online futures account username and password. I understand I should keep this username and password confidential, otherwise my Global online futures account, together with my personal information therein, may be accessed by unauthorized persons. If I forget or misplace my username and/or password, I agree to notify Global promptly so the username and/or password can be changed.

Statements via Email or Online Access: I acknowledge that all daily and monthly statements will be in PDF format, and that my personal computer will be able to read these statements because it has the required software to do so. I also acknowledge that my personal computer has the functional capability to store and/or print any statements delivered via online access or by email which I choose to archive on my personal computer or retain in hardcopy (printed) form.
3. Statements via Mail: I acknowledge I will not receive physical statements if I elect to receive them via online access and/or email.
4. Should I not be able to routinely access my email, Global online futures account, or print statements using my personal computer printer due to a computer/printer malfunction, I will request Global to provide me with the applicable statements at no cost to myself. In these and similar circumstances, I agree to promptly notify Global by mail or fax of these problems and instruct it to provide me with paper copies of all statements until further notice.
5. I acknowledge that by accessing my email or online account through the medium of the internet I will be obtaining confidential information which may be intercepted or “hacked” by unauthorized third parties. I hereby release Global from any losses or damages which I may sustain as a result of the unauthorized use of my username, password and confidential information.

NOTES RE: ONLINE FUTURES ACCOUNT AND EMAIL
SERVICES AUTHORIZATION

1. The choice as to the format in which you wish to receive copies of your daily and monthly statements depends on your personal preference. *You do not have to elect the online account and/or email format if you prefer to continue to receive them in a printed version through the mail. Please note if you decide to receive statements in electronic format, you will no longer receive a printed version.* Also note that if you decide to receive these documents in electronic format, you will *not* be able to split the electronic package of documents by electing to receive one type of statement (for example, daily statements only) in electronic format and the other type (for example, monthly statements) in printed form.
2. There are several versions of Adobe Reader. Generally speaking, subsequent versions modify and enhance previously-existing versions. While previous versions may be able to read the daily and monthly statements delivered to your online futures account, it would be preferable to read these documents with a more recent version of Reader. It is generally available for downloading from the internet free of charge.
3. The ability of your personal computer to download and store (or “archive”) the PDF versions of the daily and monthly statements delivered to your online futures account or emailed to you will depend primarily on the available computer data storage (or “random access memory”, sometimes called “RAM”) you have on your personal computer. If you wish to retain copies of the electronic version in hard copy format, you may do so by toggling the “print” button on your personal computer.
4. Should you wish to receive a copy of any particular daily or monthly statement, you may do so at any time by requesting your futures account representative to provide the copy to you, free of charge.
5. By agreeing to accept daily and monthly statements in an electronic format (as described in the authorization form), you accept that such delivery will constitute good and sufficient delivery of any document so delivered. Should Global’s electronic delivery system fail, Global will, at no cost to you, provide statements to you in paper format until Global resumes electronic deliveries.
6. Your consent to electronic deliveries may be revoked or changed at any time by notifying Global in writing by mail or fax.
